**AUTOMATIC RESERVATIONS**: If you had a table at the 2024 Show, you have an automatic reservation for the same table in 2025, but THIS RESERVATION EXPIRES DECEMBER 15, 2024. You may still apply for a table after this date, but we cannot guarantee a table after December 15. NO RESERVATIONS HONORED OR APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED WITHOUT FULL PAYMENT! Note to NEW exhibitors: your table(s) will be assigned after 12/15/2024. If you are adding an additional table that you did not previously hold, your location may be moved depending on the availability of the table next to you.

**ALL TABLE-HOLDERS AND VISITORS** agree to abide by the OKCA Show rules and to hold the OKCA, its officers, and the Lane Events Center harmless for any accident, loss, damage, theft, or injury.

ANY QUESTION OR DISPUTE arising during the Show shall be resolved by the Show Chair, whose decision shall be final.

THIS IS A KNIFE SHOW. All tables must be 90% knives or knife related items (e.g. swords, axes, edged tools, edged weapons, knife books, knifemaking supplies). If in doubt, check with the Show Chair ahead of time. The OKCA reserves the right to bar any item from display or sale. No firearms may be sold or shown at this Show.

ALL EXHIBITORS are required to keep their tables set up throughout the public hours of the Show: 8 AM Saturday to 3 PM Sunday. ANY EXHIBITOR WHO LEAVES OR COVERS THEIR TABLE BEFORE 3 PM SUNDAY FORFEITS FUTURE RESERVATIONS AND WILL BE DENIED TABLES AT FUTURE OREGON KNIFE SHOWS. EXHIBITOR TABLES ARE TO BE PACKED UP AND OUT OF THE BUILDING BY 5PM SUNDAY.

**DISPLAY TABLES** will be around the perimeter of the room. Displays are eligible for display awards, which are hand-made knives donated by members and supporters of OKCA. Display judging will be by rules established by OKCA. Special category awards may also be offered. NOTHING MAY BE SOLD FROM DISPLAY TABLES.

**SALE/TRADE TABLES** Sharing of tables will not be allowed. Exhibitors must comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws. Oregon has NO SALES TAX.

BADGES: Each table-holder is entitled to one additional Show badge. NO EXCEPTIONS.

**LICENSED SERVICE ANIMALS ONLY:** Unlicensed service animals or pets are not permitted in the buildings of the Lane County fairgrounds and will be asked by the fairgrounds administration to leave the premises.

KNIFEMAKERS who are present and are table-holders at this Show may enter knives in the knifemaking award competition.

FOR MORE INFORMATION on categories and judging criteria in the display and hand-made knife competitions, contact the Club.

**SHOW FACILITATORS** will be provided by OKCA from 9AM Friday until 4 PM Sunday. However, exhibitors are responsible for watching their own tables. Neither the OKCA nor the Lane Events Center will be responsible for any loss, theft, damage, or injury of any kind.

CITY AND COUNTY REGULATIONS require that there be: • No Smoking within the Exhibit Hall at any time; •No alcoholic beverages consumed within the Exhibit Hall during the public hours of the Show; •No loaded firearms worn or displayed at the Show; •No swords or knives brandished or displayed in a provocative manner.•All blades must have their tips/points facing away from the aisle.

NOTE ON SWITCHBLADES AND DAGGERS: In Oregon it is legal to make, sell, buy, or own switchblade knives. However, it is ILLEGAL to carry a switchblade knife, a gravity knife, a dagger, or a dirk concealed on one's person, or for a convicted felon to possess a switchblade or gravity knife. Most other states have banned switchblade knives. Under federal law, it is ILLEGAL to mail, carry, or ship a switchblade or gravity knife across state lines. The Oregon Knife Collectors Association is not responsible for force majeure.

The numbering and the OKCA club beaver logo will be engraved on the blade.



## **Demonstrations & Educational Seminars At The Show**

The demonstrations on Saturday will feature various facets of the cutlery world. The seminars or demonstrations will vary from the educational to entertaining.

Martial Arts, Boxing Within Stick and Knife - Martial Arts expert Bobby Stroup will demonstrate a history of boxing and how its framework is used and how it fits within bladed and impact weapon use. Bobby always puts on a good show! - 1pm

#### Spark Testing, Basic Metallurgy

- Knifemaker Martin Brandt will demonstrate the usefulness of spark testing. Applying a piece of steel to a grinder and observing the spark patterns and color can be a valuable aid to a knife maker. Sparks can be compared to a chart or known test samples to help in aiding with steel identification, carbon content, etc. - 10am

Knife Sharpening, - Knifemaker Lynn Moore will perform his annual demo on knife sharpening. One of our most well attended events, Lynn will discuss the concepts of edge geometry and how it pertains to sharpness. You will learn that with some very basic sharpening equipment, even a novice knife owner can keep their cutting tools razor sharp and cutting effectively. - 12pm

Rope Cutting - This demonstration/competition is back after many years, and we're excited! It's always a crowd pleaser. Knifemaker Ed Schempp will moderate this contest. The cutting of a free hanging rope or a bundle of ropes is a very popular test that shows that the knife maker understands heat treating, edge geometry, and sharpness. If you haven't seen it before, come and enjoy it. - 3pm

### Filipino Martial Arts -The combat system of Pekiti-Tirsia Kali - Ferd Terado

Ferd will talk about the combat system itself, its history and lineage. He will next showcase some of the real edged weaponry like the short

sword (ginuntings), knives and even a live-blade spear. Next will be a martial demo of how these weapons are used. This is a live presentation that will be highly physical and dynamic. A must see demonstration. - 11am

## Buying a Broken, Worn Out, Grade POOR Knife By BK Brooks

Just what got into me? The knife blade was sharpened, way over sharpened, easily 60% of the blade gone. Was the blade a spearpoint, clip point, hawkbill pruner, a wharncliffe or a whoseewhatsit? Rust on the knife was abundant. The tang mark was there but worn, The bolsters were fair as were the wood handles. The description on eBay was broken.

The handmaiden to this ill advised purchase was my long time tablemate Mark Zalesky, who knew my peccadillos and soft spots in knife collecting. He emails me this eBay item saying: "Wowza this tang mark really looks old, have you seen one before?" I had to agree it looked really old and was not one I had seen before. It had under the maker's name what the seller called fish hooks.

The knife, a junker at best, seemed to back up the age being old. Now Mark knew I had been collecting pictures of this particular maker(s)

tang marks. I had picked his brain, we have had discussions of them, their lineage, locations and incarnations. I own a few but could never collect all the tang marks of these knives as it would take a very large lottery win and years more

collecting which I don't have. Many cost "big time wrestling money" and some are very early switchblades. Plus it is not just a maker but a family name that many makers had in merry old Sheffield.

Now many may have guessed the name I am referring to, or already

looked at the accompanying pictures. Wragg of Sheffield is the name and it consists of many makers, some close kin and in Sheffield it's as common a name as Smith or Jones in the USA. Trying to

sort out the makers with the tang mark Wragg is hard as trying to

> make out various breeds of a bag full of cats during a moonless night with your bare hands.

Some Wragg makers made knives on one street and moved to another which may have had other Wragg makers on the same street. Some marked Wragg and Sons with no other clues but different styles of the tang mark.There are Wraggs on street names like Solly Street, Charles street. Harwood street. Denby Street and with various assorted street numbers on Furnace Hill. Some were taken

over by their son or relative whose name was attached or transferred to the knife tang mark later. One Wragg company was named after



the father John Wragg, but actually started by his son Joseph, the father previously making his fortune as a purveyor of "pickled eggs" famous throughout England! L C Wragg made the impressive Texas Longhorn style guard bowie, while Samuel C Wragg made the double horse head guard with alligator



bowie knife, what are called "fat folders" and also manufactured various switchblades. John, or Thorpe or W H made table knives, campaign knives or plain looking folders. There is even a Ragg knife maker in Sheffield. I have tried numerous times in an article to write the lineage of Wragg but without success. It just become a tangled mess of confusion and speculation

Now this Junker I bought has no clues but it's obvious age. It clearly says WRAGG. There is nothing to say it is Sheffield made. As the buyer describes them there are two fish hook looking stamps below the WRAGG. The wood on one handle is a natural two tone dark brown and yellowish brown with iron pins. "Old it is, but undefined" says Yoda. But not as old as I feel when my lineage of Wragg makers article will never come to be. Something for the next generation to decipher.
